

**2011 DOGS VICTORIA AGILITY STATE CHAMPION
and
2011 DOGS VICTORIA AGILITY TOP DOG**

Selection for the award will be made on the following basis:

1. Competitors will nominate up to 20 Master Agility qualifying passes.
2. Passes will be gained from any Master Agility Class with the following restrictions:
 - a. Maximum of three (3) passes gained from interstate.
 - b. Passes from Restricted to Breed, Height or Group Trials are not eligible.
3. Placing's will be in accordance with ANKC Agility Rules
4. Passes to be gained at Trials between 1st August 2010 and 31st July 2011.
5. Closing date for submission of passes will be Friday 5th August, 2011.
Entries to include photocopies of all nominated passes and a completed ANKC entry form.
6. Competitors must be residents of Victoria.
7. Dogs must be registered with Dogs Victoria Inc.
8. The "Top Dog" final is to be conducted in conjunction with the State Agility Trial in 2011 and will be based on one round of a Master Agility Class.
9. Results to be submitted to the Agility Committee which will select 10 finalists and 3 reserves based on the order of the highest points.
10. Selection of the 2011 "Agility State Champion" will be based on the highest points scored during the qualifying period.
11. If trials have been run using separate height classes, points will be determined by the overall winner based on raw times.

Passes will be assigned a points value. A maximum of 150 points will be possible.

Points are assigned as follows:

1 st	10 points	6 th	5 points
2 nd	9 points	7 th	4 points
3 rd	8 points	8 th	3 points
4 th	7 points	9 th	2 points
5 th	6 points	10 th	1 point

The above table is based on the maximum number of points available to be gained at each trial.
