An information night covering DOGS Victoria members' responsibilities under the relevant legislation, rules, regulations and codes

The granting of Applicable Organisation status to DOGS Victoria by the Minister for Agriculture and Food Security is with the understanding that DOGS Victoria must ensure that all members are aware of the requirements of both the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animal Act 1986* and *Domestic Animals Act 1994*.

This seminar will be presented by Steve Moore, (Licensing and Audit Officer), Bureau of Animal Welfare, Department of Primary Industry. The items covered will include:

All members of DOGS Victoria will be required to annually complete and sign a Compliance Questionnaire which will be a declaration that you are aware of your responsibilities under the legislation and codes mentioned above in regard to the numbers of dogs kept on your property, their registration requirements and depending on the number of fertile bitches housed, your consequent responsibilities under the *Domestic Animals Act 1994*
