Procedure for Application of AAOS A20 CAC

Introduction

1. Once a dog has gained sufficient CAC Awards in accordance with Dogs Australia Regulations Part 5 – Show, Section 9A.7 the registered owner/s of the dog may make application to the A2O Secretariat through their Member Body for the title of A20 Champion, A20 Grand Champion or A20 Supreme Champion.

Procedure

2. The procedure for making application for the abovementioned titles shall be as follows:
 - a. The owner/s are to complete the attached form provide the original pedigree and the copies of the CAC's being claimed to Dogs Victoria. Along with the prescribed fee as determined by Dogs Australia and the Member Body.
 - b. The Member Body is to verify the information and once confirmed forward to Dogs Australia in the format below, for application to be made to the A2O Secretariat.
 - 1) Completed Application;
 - 2) Pedigree Front;
 - 3) Pedigree Rear; and
 - 4) A2OCS CACs in order as listed on the application.
 - c. If approved by the A2O Secretariat and the Member Body notified via Dogs Australia or verified proof from the owner/s, the Member Body is to issue a new pedigree reflecting the title.
