12.1 ORGANISATION AND ADMINISTRATION

12.1.1 All fixture schedules must be published in the Gazette. Draft schedules and judges contracts must be submitted to Dogs Victoria office for approval at least four months prior to the first of the month in which the fixture is being held. Failure to comply will result in a late fee of \$100 being applied. (15/03/22)

When scheduling a competition for dates when it is reasonably expected that the competition may be affected by high temperatures, consideration must be given to:

- scheduling an earlier start than usual
- provision of shade at the rings for judges, stewards and competitors waiting to compete (if the competition is to be conducted outdoors)
- provision of drinking water at the ring for judges and stewards
- provision of drinking water and paddling pools for use by the dogs; and
- scheduling to ensure that officials can be rotated during the day.

Judges and other officials' fees are to be paid before the conclusion of the event

12.3.4 CANCELLATION OF A COMPETITION

• a competition is to be cancelled when the forecast temperature reaches 34 degrees Celsius

Where multiple competitions are scheduled over a day or a number of days, then a case-by-case (competition-by-competition) decision shall be made.

12.3.10 REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES FOR EVENTS CANCELLED DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER

12.3.11 STATUS OF AWARDS WHEN AN EVENT IS CANCELLED DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER

For classes completed or commenced (but not completed)

- All prizes/places shall be awarded
- All qualification cards shall be awarded
- All qualifications gained will be eligible for DOGS AUSTRALIA titles

For classes completed, points from all applicable classes will count towards Top Dog qualification (if applicable).

For classes commenced but not completed, points from all applicable classes will NOT count towards Top Dog qualification (if applicable).
